



Summary of DEIS Actions Year 3

Deis Literacy Actions 2022-2023 Year 3

- CPD training at school and class level in the New Primary Language Curriculum in Term 2.
- Engagement with the Folens Starlight Oral Language Programme at class level with use of new planning terminology and linking oral genres with current whole school plan
- Individualized spelling programmes to cater for the student.
- SGLI: Whole school initiative to further improve all aspects of the literacy curriculum.
- BB: Piloting the first 3 stages of the “Building Bridges” programme in the two mainstream classrooms.
- Differentiated small group literacy intervention for students of a below average reading age.

Deis Numeracy Actions 2022-2023 Year 3

- Celebrate maths week
- Implement a whole school overview structured plan to be implemented by all staff.
- Create “number” as the focus for the year
- Streamed classes according to ability
- Use of logistic games to encourage transfer of skills to everyday maths.
- Ongoing and regular assessment to ensure all students are making ongoing progress.

Attendance , retention and transition Actions 2022-2023 Year 3

- Identify pupils not attending school regularly.
- Monthly meetings with Diane and Tommy to focus on these students
- Monthly assemblies offer rewards and incentives
- Text messages to be sent out reminding parents to send in doctors certs and letters explaining absences.
- Use student voice to get ideas to promote attendance-student council

Transitions Actions 2022-2023 Year 3

- Diane to support filling out the CAS forms in October/November
- Use of the engage program, college visits and incentives to promote secondary school
- Smooth transition from the 1st class girls school with the support of Diane and Tommy.
- Principal and Deputy principal to meet with parents on an Open school day.
- Graduation Day to be conducted to celebrate and promote the pupils' accomplishments.
